



Qualified Compact Flash (CF) Cards

There are a large number of CompactFlash (CF) cards available in the marketplace, however not all CF cards provide sufficient bandwidth for use with the AJA Ki Pro Mini. The following CF cards have been tested and are AJA qualified for use with the AJA Ki Pro Mini as of January 2011.
